## Overview

Professor John Carter is a distinguished figure in the field of medicine, specialising in endocrinology. He completed his undergraduate and initial medical training at the University of Sydney, achieving his BSc in 1967 and his MBBS in 1969. Furthering his education, he earned an MD from the University of New South Wales in 1976. Professor Carter's professional qualifications are complemented by his membership in the Royal Australasian College of Physicians (MRACP 1972, FRACP 1976) and his roles as an accredited health practitioner in various New South Wales health and accident services. His career in academia is marked by his long-standing affiliation with the University of Sydney, where he has been serving as a Clinical Professor of Medicine since 2010.

Professor Carter's clinical and research career has been both rich and impactful, having held several key positions in major hospitals across Sydney. He was the foundation director of the Endocrine Unit at Repatriation General Hospital Concord from 1977 to 1983 and has held senior visiting medical officer positions in endocrinology at Hornsby Ku-ring-gai and Concord Hospitals. His research interests have led him to significant roles, including serving as a councillor and president of the Australian Diabetes Society. His extensive work in diabetes management and policy formulation at the national level was recognized with an Order of Australia in 2000. Currently, he also holds a Consultant Emeritus position at the North Sydney Local Health District, highlighting his ongoing commitment to medical practice and education.
