He has had several senior leadership roles on the Royal College of Surgeons Council and the Australian Orthopaedic Association Board. He took a particular interest in professional development and standards of both organisations. He has given over 150 scientific presentations and published over 40 times in the areas of surgical standards and orthopaedic oncology.
